2. Students who are active English Learners must have passed the ACCESS English proficiency exam (administered in grade eleven) at the "proficient" level (i.e., composite score of 5.0 or higher).

Demonstrate Proficiency in target World Language:

1. As part of the application process, you will meet with a teacher or community leader who is also proficient in your target language. The interview is an informal conversation. You will be assessed using the proficiency guidelines developed by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Language (ACTFL). You will receive more information about the interview after your application is received.
